

IFSC Climbing World Cup Villars 2021

Dear media professionals,

On behalf of Villars Tourisme and the Swiss Alpine Club (SAC), I'd like to welcome you to the Lead and Speed World Cup in Villars-sur-Ollon, which will take place from 1 to 3 July.

Please take note of the following points, which will allow you all to work in the best possible conditions:

- Information about the competitions
- To be allowed on site, you need to either:
 - be fully vaccinated and present your vaccination certificate (only valid with QR
 Code) and your ID upon arrival;
 - present proof of a negative PCR test carried out within the last 72 hours (only valid with QR Code);
 - present proof of a negative antigen test carried out within the last 48 hours (only valid with QR Code, self-tests are not authorised);
 - or have recovered from the virus and present a certificate that proves that you
 are out of quarantine or that your test was positive (not more than six months
 ago and only valid with QR Code).
- You can be tested on site (please bring your health insurance card)


Thursday from 6.30am to 12pm Friday from 6am to 12pm Saturday from 7am to 12pm Sunday from 6am to 9am

HOW MUCH DO TESTS COST?

Antigen tests (valid 48 hours, results available in 15 minutes) cost 20 CHF or 20 EUR. PCR tests (valid 72 hours, results available between 24 and 48 hours later) cost 120 CHF or 130 EUR.

- To be allowed on site, you need a badge, which can be obtained at the Competition venue,
 Place du Rendez-vous. Badges will only be issued to those of you who:
 - o have filled in the online health form,
 - present proof of a negative test or a vaccination certificate (only valid with QR Code). If you have recovered from the virus or have been vaccinated, you can send proof of this to me beforehand (fabienne.boegli@sac-cas.ch).
 - and present ID.

You can pick up your badge starting from Thursday 1 July from 1pm onwards, at the Competition venue, Place du Rendez-vous. If you'd like to pick it up earlier, please let me know (fabienne.boegli@saccas.ch).
