

Hello everyone,


We would like to thank you for your commitment during the Villars Climbing World Cup, without you this event could not take place.

As you know, the current health regulations place certain constraints on us. According to the Federal Council's decision of 23 June 2021, from 1 July 2021, access to major events will be limited to people who are in possession of a COVID certificate. You can present yourself with the paper version or download it onto your smartphone using the COVID Certificate application.

The COVID certificate contains, in addition to the surname, first name, date of birth and a certificate number, information about the COVID-19 vaccination, the cure or the negative result of a PCR test or a rapid antigen test. It is only valid with an identity document. Example of the paper COVID certificate

For Europeans, please take your European COVID certificate with you.

Access to the event site will only be authorised on presentation of all these documents.

For those who are not in possession of these documents, we can provide antigenic tests (valid for 48 hours) at the Villars sports centre (tennis).
