



IFSC Europe Extraordinary PA 2019 in Nuremberg, November 23rd 2019

Dear National Federations

On behalf of the IFSC Board I have the pleasure of inviting you to attend an Extraordinary Plenary Assembly of IFSC Europe on November 23rd in Nuremberg, Germany.

Our Board has taken the decision to hold an Extraordinary PA (ExPA) for several reasons. The proposal to have an ExPA was discussed and warmly supported by National Federations (NFs) represented at the Vilnius PA in May this year due to the ongoing and rapidly developing discussion about Future Strategy for the IFSC. We were all determined that the views of European countries should be clearly expressed during this opportunity to set the IFSC's course for the next few years.

Delegates were also excited about the possibility of sharing proposals that individual NFs might wish to have discussed at the main IFSC Plenary. For example, NFs wished to bring better worded and better developed proposals to the IFSC Plenary in Cyprus 2020.

In Vilnius we decided that our Europe PAs will be held in Europe in November annually and so it makes sense to have an interim PA rather than having 18 months between two PAs.

It is also useful that our ExPA falls between the recent Strategy Workshop at Arco and the 2019 Climbing Summit scheduled for 14th December 2019.

Very shortly we will circulate a provisional agenda. You are also warmly invited to proposed topics.

This ExPA is to be held in the Nuremberg Convention Centre at the same time as the 'Halls and Walls' climbing equipment exhibition. Delegates may apply for a free pass for the exhibition including the Welcome event on Friday evening.

We thank our hosts, the DAV, for reserving the conference room and associated hotel rooms for the EB members and Delegates, and arranging free passes for participants to the 'Halls and Walls' event. Nuremberg itself is a most charming city to visit, with a most interesting history. We anticipate that the ExPA will be a most fruitful and enjoyable event.
