IFSC EXECUTIVE BOARD TELECONFERENCE FEBRUARY 2019

The monthly teleconference of the IFSC Executive Board took place on Wednesday 13th February. IFSC President Marco Maria Sclaris discussed developments with Executive Board and Staff members ahead of the upcoming Plenary Assembly in Tokyo, Japan.

President Sclaris first informed the Executive Board of recent visits and meetings, including a meeting with the Japan Mountaineering & Sport Climbing Association (JMSPA) in Tokyo last month, before giving an update on governance. The Board then proceeded with a review of IFSC Statutes and By-laws, with proposals to be raised with IFSC Member Federations during the Plenary Assembly.

The Administration Department reviewed changes to IFSC membership statuses and presented an update on GDPR compliance, prior to putting forward the 2019 IFSC Plenary Assembly agenda for approval by the Executive Board. Along with IFSC Vice-President Treasurer and Finances Pierre-Henri Paillason, Administration Director Francesca Jengo then gave an overview of the provisional budgets for 2019.

Ahead of the annual IFSC Officials' Seminar in Turin (ITA) this weekend (16-17th February), Sport Director Silvia Verdolini informed the Board of the Seminar's programme of events and presented the revised 2019 Nominated Officials for the Executive Board's approval. Sport Department updates were then offered, including developments in preparations for the Youth World Championships 2020 and World Championships 2021. Paraclimbing Development Officer Daniel Torchia subsequently introduced a proposed Paraclimbing Development Plan, which is to be voted on at the 2019 Plenary Assembly.

Head of Olympic Coordination Jérôme Meyer next informed the Board of updates surrounding the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020, which sees its 500-day countdown begin next month, and the Olympic Games Paris 2024. IFSC Consultant Charlotte Durif also provided a report of her ongoing project.

Sponsorship deals were then discussed by Marketing & Communications Director Anne Fuynel, who also provided the Board with information on recruitment developments as the Marketing & Communications Department searches for an Event Sponsor & Media Officer and a Venue Delegate.

The meeting concluded with a brief report from the recent Continental Council teleconference.

The next Executive Board meeting will take place during the week of the IFSC Plenary Assembly 2019 in Tokyo, Japan, on 14th, 15th and 17th March.
