IFSC WORLD CUP WUJIANG & IFSC WORLD CUP XIAMEN 2017

OND STAGE OF THE CHINA TOUR

The Speed season concludes this month and Lead champions may also be determined at the upcoming IFSC World Cup events in Wujiang and Xiamen, the second stage of the China Tour.

Chongging and Nanjing opened the Speed climbing season with record-breaking performances from Reza Alipourshenazandifar of Iran and Iuliia Kaplina of Russia. Now, the China Tour continues with the sixth and seventh IFSC World Cup events in Lead and Speed in the Southeast cities of Wujiang and Xiamen.

Second chance for Jaubert

Vladislav Deulin of Russia and Alipourshenazandifar have been hard to beat this IFSC Speed World Cup season. Both athletes topped two podiums and Alipourshenazandifar was recently crowned Asian Speed champion at the Asian Continental Championships in Tehran. Italy's Ludovico Fossali also excelled last month, rising to fourth place in the rankings with a win in Edinburgh. His teammate Leonardo Gontero and Russian athletes Stanislav Kokorin and Aleksandr Shikov can also become season champion by finishing strong in China. Speed legend Qixin Zhong of China is also on the start list.

Last year, the women's rankings came down to the final races. After setting an historic winning streak (4). Anouck Jaubert of France missed the last podium in Xiamen and placed second to Kaplina. The rivalry has continued this season, with the two Speed stars taking every Gold medal. Jaubert extended another winning streak in Edinburgh (3), and Kaplina's compatriots Mariia Krasavina and Anna Tsyganova will try to catch them both in Wujiang and Xiamen. Also keep an eve on new Asian Speed champion Puii Lestari of Indonesia and youth Asian Combined and Speed champion YiLing Song of China.

Desgranges. Garnbret one win away

In Lead, frontrunners Romain Desgranges of France and Slovenia's Janja Garnbret returned to the top of the podium in Edinburgh. Garnbret has won all but one IFSC Lead World Cup event this year and Desgranges has won three. Even with three events remaining, another win will crown them season champions if second placed Stefano Ghisolfi and Jain Kim miss one podium.

A number of strong Asian athletes are also on the start lists for Wujiang and Xiamen. Asian Bouldering champions Kokoro Fujii and Akiyo Noguchi placed first and second in Lead in Tehran, and their Bouldering teammates Mei Kotake, Yoshiyuki Ogata, Keita Watabe. Tomoa Narasaki and The World Games champion Keiichiro Korenaga will all be tying-in this month. Be sure to track the progress of youth Asian Combined champion Pan YuFei and HaiBin Ou of China as well, who excelled in Tehran.
