Atlanta After-Competition Report - 29.09/30.09 2012

Lead World Cup Atlanta: New Competition, same winner's smile

September 30th was again the day of Jain Kim (KOR) and Ramón Julian Puiqblanque (ESP)! Only one week after their successes at the Lead World Cup in Puurs Korea's vice world champion and Spain's world champion from 2011 celebrated their season's second victory each in Atlanta (USA).

Atlanta, 1st October 2012 - More than 70 athletes from all over the world took part in the only Lead World Cup event in America this year at Stone Summit Climbing and Fitness in Atlanta, Georgia. And just like in the first World Cup after the Climbing World Championships 2012 it was on Jain Kim and Ramón Julian Puiqblanque to show their great autumn shape.

In the women's competition Korea's guarantor of success, Jain Kim, secured her second win in a row – in absence of reigning world champion Angela Eiter – followed by Lead Overall World Cup leader Mina Markovic and Maja Vidmar (both SLO). France's Hélène Janicot, leader after the semi-final, dropped to sixth.

The second victory of the day went to another well-known podium climber: Ramón Julian Puiqblanque from Spain celebrated his second victory of the season, followed by fledgling world champion Jakob Schubert (AUT) and France's routinier Romain Desranges (leader after the semi-final).

The next stage for the world's best lead and speed climbers will be the IFSC Lead World Cup in Xining (CHN), coming up from October 12th to 13th. Further information and a detailed schedule on www.ifsc-climbing.org.
