Mokpo After-Competition Report – 20-21 October 2012

Fast, faster, Russia: Gaydamakina and Kokorin are the winners of the IFSC Speed overall World Cup 2012!

Thrilling decisions and all in all six winners are the result of a fascinating climbing weekend in Mokpo (KOR). Alina Gaydamakina and Stanislav Kokorin fixed their titles as the world's fastest climbers in 2012, the stage wins went to Yuliya Levochkina and Danylo Boldyrev (Speed) resp. Jain Kim and Hyunbin Min (Lead).

It was the day of Russian speed in Korea this weekend: With places five and four Alina Gaydamakina and Stanislav Kokorin, the most constant Speed climbers of this season, celebrated their successes in the IFSC Speed Overall World Cup 2012. For the 22-year-old Kokorin it's his already second success after 2010, his compatriot Alina Gaydamakina celebrates her first triumph in an IFSC World Cup.

Another premiere was due in the Mokpo Lead contest: Hyunbin Min reached his first gold medal in an IFSC World Cup competition on native soil, supported by countrywoman Jain Kim who strengthened her place two in the Lead overall World Cup. World Cup leader Mina Markovic (SLO) came in second, followed by youngster Dinara Fakhritdinova from Russia. In





the men's Lead World Cup things are still very tense after the competition in Korea. Japan's Sachi Amma reconquered his leading position in the overall calculation with place two in Mokpo, followed by prior leader Ramón Julian Puigblanque (5th in Mokpo) and Sean McColl from Canada, third-place finisher in Korea. Reigning world champion Jakob Schubert (AUS) finished 6th in Mokpo and seized his mathematical odds in the Lead World Cup.

And there's nearly no time to rest for the world's best Lead climbers these days. Already on October 27th the IFSC retinue is moving on to Inzai (JAP) for this year's second last World Cup. The final competition in 2012 will subsequently be held in Kranj (SLO) on November 27th-28th.
